6. Juba Joint Pentangular Project Report Margaret Griffin.
 - MG, R.B-H TP to present details to Joint Pentangular Meeting 28th November.
 - MG feed-back on current situation:
 - A new Headteacher has been appointed. 3/30 Teachers are women (consistent with the aim of educating girls to undertake roles in SS society.). The School is conducting a 1 year Pilot called "Teach First" to train teachers on behalf of the South Sudan Government. For the 3rd year running (i.e. the life of the Project) all of the year group were successful in the School Certificate, one student was top National achiever and 3 gained free scholarships to study in Ankara University, Turkey. For the first time, Sport is on the Curriculum. An established Interact Club operates and Juba, meeting during Security Curfew, has a responsibility to develop other Rotary Clubs nationally. MG explained the precise allocation of the 103,000 dollar Pentangular Budget was dependent on the inflationary development of the Economy.
