### NOTES

- 1 If your declaration covers donations that you make in the future please notify The Rotary Club of Canterbury Charity Trust Fund (RCCCTF) if you change your name and address while the declaration is still in force. You can cancel the declaration at any time by notifying RCCCTF; it will then not apply to donations that you make on or after the date of cancellation or such later date as you specify.
- 2 You must pay an amount of Income Tax and/or Capital Gains Tax at least equal to the tax that the RCCCTF reclaims on your donation in the tax year (currently 25p for each £1 that you give).
- 3 If in the future your circumstances change and you no longer pay tax on your income and capital gains equal to that which the RCCCTF reclaims, you can cancel your declaration (see note 1).
- 4 The amount paid by the donor is treated as "net" amount after deduction of basic rate income tax, which the charity can claim back from the Inland Revenue. Donors who pay income tax at the higher rate can claim higher rate tax relief in their tax return (at the difference between the higher rate and the basic rate).
- 5 If you are unsure whether your donations qualify for Gift Aid relief, ask the RCCCTF, or you can ask your local tax office for leaflet IR113 Gift Aid.
