<b>CLUB FUNDS</b> General Fund 100th Anniversary 100 Club Website & Event Manager System Fellowship Activities	Covers all general expenses, ie badges, stamps, stationary, meeting fees, archive storage etc. etc. Reserves built up over next two years to cover event costs and subsidise members attendance. Covers President's annual Pentangular gift of 400 euros with balance transferred to Mini Group Exchange to cover cost of sending delegates. Covers domain renewal, website hosting, event manager system and othe IT costs. Rotary having fun!
Pentangular 2022	Reserves built up annually to cover members attendance at the Pentangular 2022 events. Also covers Presidents expenses in attending annual Presidents meetings.
Mini Group exchange RIBI Subscriptions District Subscriptions	Funds MGE student expenses and builds up annually to cover cost of hosting next MGE in 2023. Paid in two 6 monthly tranches to RIBI, this year £65 per head. Paid annually in August, this year £10 per head.
DINING ACCOUNT	Covers all costs associated with dining, contributes to event management system, tips to catering staff, flowers to Rotary widows at Christmas, speaker expenses etc.
CHARITY ACCOUNT Emergency Reserve Vocational Services Foundation Charity General Account Presidents Charities	Reserved for immediate donation in the event of an emergency. Funds available for use by the Vocational Committee. Income collected from Club members at time of subscription and 100% sent on to Rotary Foundation. Covers unassociated charitable income and expenses. Certain specified event raffles and collections for distribution by President at end of year for his/her nominated charities.
Wishing Well	Usually on 50:50 arrangement with host's (ie Tesco/Sainsburys) charity of choice. Remaining Rotary 50% share for distribution amongst the Club's Charity accounts.
Weekly Raffle JPP 4 Contribution to St Quentin Community Service Committee International Committee	Profits currently accrued 100% for Shelterbox. A decision is required to be taken as to whether to include Aquabox and Wateraid, as possibly in past. 2000 euros due for payment this September 2019. Futher payments to follow 2020 and 2021. Accrued from charitable income Funds available for use by the Community Service Committee. Funds available for use by the International Committee.
<b>EVENTS ACCOUNT</b> Sailor Ted Caption Competition	All fundraising events run from this account providing cash for deposits/expenses and protection of Club members in the event that an event goes wrong. Once money is transferred out to the Charity Account it cannot return. Accounted for here and the profit transferred to the Charity Account. Accounted for here and the profit transferred to the Charity Account.

Investments	The Millennium Trust Fund has investments in M & G Equities and CCLA investment Funds.
COIF Funds Available	Dividends from the CCLA Investment Fund are paid into this account. The money from this account can either be drawn down directly into the NatWest account as and when required or re-invested as required by the Trustees.
Nat West Funds Available	Dividends from the M & G Equities and the interest from the CCLA Investment Funds are paid into the NatWest Bank account. All grants are paid from this account
JPP 3 ACCOUNTS JPP Dollar Account JPP Sterling Account	Contributions from Pentangular partners are received into this account and payments to Juba are made from here. Canterbury Clubs fundraising for JPP3 is banked here and transferred into dollars in the dollar account.
