- 1. Minutes. The Minutes of the meeting held on 22 January 2019 were agreed.
- 2. Charitable Funds Available: £3394.00
- 3. **Donations Made.** £295 to Tools for Self Reliance, £500 for Parkinson's UK.
- **4. Buster's Book Club** HC reported that Parkside Primary School is still keen they hoped to have a start date soon.
- **5. Website Requests: Music 4 Wellbeing.** DC had tried to make contact but had received no answer to her emails decision: no further action.
- **6. Wheel Potential.** A presentation of our cheque for £460 will be made at a club meeting in the near future.

- **8. Tools for Self Reliance (TSR).** RA agreed to arrange a visit to the TSR workshop, date to be arranged.
