Open Farm Day (Intl fundraising event):

Venue:

- Robert's farm arable farm, has large woodland and wildflower areas
- Concrete floored barn is available if needed in case of bad weather
- Car parking plenty available on site. Mike to supervise on the day
- Signs need signage to the farm, to toilets etc. Robert and Gerald to make signs
- Will also have balloons to help identify location (see below). Some areas (e.g. house) to be taped off
- Misc assistance Caroline to assist with various tasks on the day

Food & drink:

- Hog roast, veggie option, salads organised and provided by the caterer. He will provide all
 plates/cutlery. Has food safety certificate that will cover the event. Will cater for 135 (but see note
 below) at a total cost of £700
- Drinks attendees to bring their own, so no licensing issues. Jugs of (tap) water will be available
- Tea, coffee, fruit (raspberries/strawberries) & cream organised and provided by Wendy/Sheila (Robert's wife). Wendy to follow up on plates and cutlery

Stalls:

- Cake stall to be manned by Julie/Mary. Items will be for sale (not in ticket price) **Wendy to look** into cake boxes. Wendy to bake cupcakes, Julie to decorate. Others may also make cakes etc.
- Bring & buy stall to be manned by Mary's daughter Francesca/??

Fun & games:

- Bouncy castle Robert has found someone that will provide castle for £70. Robert to explore disco
 option with them
- Sponsored game Robert to follow up with potential sponsors
- Catch-a-Duck (not in ticket price) to be manned by Kailash. Julie to buy more small ducks
- Coconut shy (not in ticket price) to be manned by Viv. Viv to collect shy from chapel
- Raffle (not in ticket price) to be manned by Gill/Graham. Gill/others to try and get raffles prizes

Other activities:

- Various vehicles on display for 'inspection': e.g. JCB, fork lift truck (latter with kite bird repeller) etc
- Woodland walk/wildflower walks-signs to be erected
- Photos opps people will be able to take own photos. Robert to deliver plywood to Julie. Julie to paint cut-out board

Publicity:

- No invitations to the public but will publicise input from sponsors. Robert to provide Julie with details of sponsors and the hog roast person etc.
- Email invite to Rotarians, cluster. Robert to ask Neil Fraser to circulate and request raffle prizes
- Invites to district via Hilary Brian? Caroline to follow up once signed off poster is available

Items needed:

 Trestle tables (Robert has two, but need to find two more at least). Robert to explore borrowing from village hall.

Misc decisions:

- NOT an event for the general public for Rotarians, friends & family only Fundraising for Juba but won't state this on publicity materials
- All health, hygiene and risk assessments are in place; Dogs allowed on leads
- No need for first aider as several doctors/nurses will be on site
- Mobile/portaloos will be hired Robert to follow up on sponsorship
- NOTE: We want to encourage as many people as possible. If numbers go beyond 135 we will request another hog roast. Should know well in advance from Wendy
- Poster Julie to revise wording as agreed Robert to sign off, Gerald to print
- Tickets A6 tickets with map on back. Julie to design; Robert to sign off, Gerald to print
- Ticket sale tickets only via Wendy who will maintain a list of who has bought them. Per head pricing: £18 for adults and over 12s. £40 for family ticket (2 adults and up to 3 children under 12).
 Free for babies and toddlers under 3.
- Balloons & loudhailer Robert to investigate helium balloon kit & loudhailer for the Club
- Music Included with Bouncy Castle
- No need to provide carrier bags etc bring their own or put into cars
- We will not be having ducks for sponsorship, but will publicise the duck race
- Tabards Viv to collect from chapel (including coconut shy, some ducks and other misc items)
