Buurtwerk Het Lampeke has been active in a very diverse neighbourhood in Leuven for 50 years and works with the underprivileged target group: people who, for whatever reason, are or are likely to become socially vulnerable. They want to take people out of their social isolation by organizing all kinds of connecting activities in a safe environment. The neighbourhood activities mainly revolve around day care for babies and toddlers, working with children from nursery and primary school (and their parents / families) and young people up to 25 years.
