- 1 (a) At 12 March 2024, the sum of £5,131.00 has been received from Rotarians on account of their future dining costs. At that date, some Rotarians owe a total of £515.50 for meals that they have taken but not yet paid for which leaves a net sum of £4,615.50 as repayable to Rotarians and that is accrued above. There is a deficit on the 2023/24 Dining fund of £120.17 as shown above for free meals provided to guests of the Club.
- 1 (b) The cost of the meals provided on 6 February 2024 amounted a total of £1,757.97 which was paid on 5 March. The cost of the meals taken on 5 March was £573.75 and those taken on 12 March was £596.70. £1,170.45 due to Sodexo Prestige Ltd is accrued above.
- 2 Council has agreed that the Dining General Funds are to be used to meet the costs of future speakers and their meals, and also for the costs of special events subject to the prior authorisation of the President. In accordance with the Club Council decision, the EMS support costs for 2024/25 will be invoiced at £600 by Extra Digital Ltd in May 2024 and is accrued as charged against this fund.
