- 1 (a) 43 members of the Rotary Club have paid full 2024/25 Presidential year membership subscriptions. 4 new members have paid part of the full year's membership subscription and one new member is paying her subscription for 8 months of the 2024/25 Presidential year by instalments. One member has paid her 2024/25 membership subscription by instalments. She is paying too much each month so she is now making payments on account of her 2025/26 Presidential year subscription. There is one Honorary Member who pays no subscription.
- 2 The balance of £1,305.25 on the Centenary Dinner fund is to be retained to contribute to the costs of a celebration when 'The Water Point' is commissioned.
- 3 Club Council has set up a fund to contribute towards the costs of the Mini-Group Study Exchange (MGSE) to be hosted by RC Canterbury in the summer of 2025. These funds were reallocated from what is believed to be a surplus of funding in other Club Administration Account funds.
- 4 27 members of the Club and 2 supporters have taken subscriptions for 49 numbers in the 100 Club for the year to 30 June 2025. The third draw prize was won by John Hill and this will be paid out in the near future. The prize due to John Hill. The balance of one prize for the year of £100 is accrued above. The balance of any funds raised will be used to contribute towards the gift to a charity nominated by RC Leuven during the 2025 Pentangular event.
