- 1 35 members of the Rotary Club have paid the full 2025/26 Presidential year membership subscription. There are three Honorary Members in total who pay no subscription.
- 2 The balance of £148.69 on the Water Point Celebration Fund shown above is available to contribute towards other costs of the project. 'The Water Point' was commissioned on 29 April 2025.
- 3 In the 2025/26 Presidential year, Rotarians are contributing £6.00 each towards the costs of the next MGSE that will be hosted by RCC in 2030.
- 4 During the 2024/25 Presidential year, Club Council set aside a fund of £1,000.00 to contribute towards the costs of the Mini-Group Study Exchange (MGSE) to be hosted by RC Canterbury in the summer of 2025. Contributions totalling £2,734.95 have now been received from all of the Pentangular Clubs who are sending delegates.
- 5 23 members of the Club and 1 supporter have taken subscriptions for 41 numbers in the 100 Club for the year to 30 June 2026. Four prize draws at £100.00 each are accrued for. The balance of the funds generated by this activity is to be paid to RC Ludenscheid to contribute as part of the gift of Euro 500 to the charity nominated by them as part of the 2026 Pentangular event.
